As of September 3rd 2019 all Paramedics in Ontario transitioned to version 4.6 of the ALS PCS

The changes that are reflected in the updated ALS PCS are as follows:

- Emergency Tracheostomy Tube Reinsertion Medical Directive moves from auxiliary to core (both PCP and ACP)
- Adult Analgesia Medical Directive removed (both PCP and ACP)
- Analgesia Medical Directive moves from auxiliary to core (both PCP and ACP)
- Pediatric Analgesia Medical Directive removed (ACP only)
- New Research Trial Standard added in appendix 7

Please note, there is no change to current paramedic practice, no operational impact and no additional costs associated with the publication of this update.
